Dear Respublicans,

Now that we are moving to Level 3 Lockdown, we are excited to be able to welcome you back to your res soon! Our re-admission process is aligned with the phased return of approved student cohorts to campus as recently announced by the Department of Higher Education and Training starting from 15 June 2020 or in accordance with your own Institutions timetable. We are required to phase the re-admission process in line with the ministerial regulations as well as to avoid large gatherings of students on readmission at residences as they proceed through the health screening and administrative process.

Please provide confirmation of your intention to return by way of email to your residence administrators, and we will then confirm your allocated return date. At that point we will communicate the necessary health and hygiene protocols that you will be required to follow in order to be readmitted back into residence. Any student that does not satisfy this criteria will not be allowed back into residence.

In anticipation of your return, the residence has undergone extensive decontamination and disinfection cleaning, including implementing the following health measures:

- Disinfection and deep cleaning of all apartments, bedrooms and common areas
- Anti-microbial fogging of areas previously occupied during lockdown
- Installation of hand sanitizers at all turnstile entrances and other high risk areas
- Demarcated of physical distancing and people densities in all public areas
- Installation of protective screens at administration areas including reception and offices
- Revised cleaning schedules for high touch areas in public and administrative areas
- Revised cleaning detergents and disinfectants
- Provided all staff with the regulatory PPE necessary
- Provided each student with two reusable residence branded cloth masks
- Revised residence house rules and regulations regarding compliance with health regulations including social distancing and hygiene practice.
- Implemented Covid-19 education and training programme for all staff and student

Important

Once approved for readmission to your residence you will be required to complete the following before being allowed to reoccupy your room;

1. Complete an online pre-health screening the day before your intended move in date
2. Complete a health screening on the day of admission at the residence
3. Sign a pledge to act in the best health interests of the residence community at all times
4. Sign and acknowledge to abide by the revised house rules covering COVID-19 protocols
5. Ensure that your rental account is fully paid up
6. Undertake to go into self-quarantine for 14 days from date of readmission.

Respublica would like to thank all our students that have kept their rental payments up to date during the lockdown period. We encourage all students who have arrears to please settle their accounts prior to returning to residence. Respublica is working on rental relief options for students that will assist you both now and later with the additional financial burden of an extended academic calendar, considering





that it is likely you will be required to stay on in residence longer than normal to complete the academic year. These will be communicated to you in due course.

We look forward to welcoming you back into your residence soon and in the meantime please keep safe and stay healthy.
