

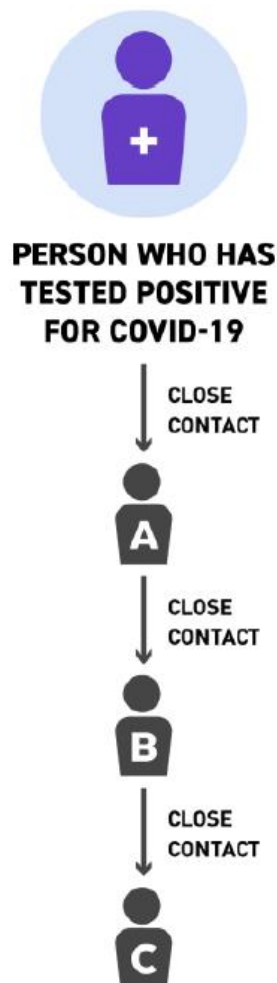

## HOW TO RESPOND TO COVID-19 WITHIN STUDENT COMMUNITIES

### 1. SYMPTOMS: Response when a student presents with one or more Covid-19 symptoms

- Student informs their Res Manager and self-quarantines (2 days)
- Student then self-medicates and tries to get better.
- Quarantine time to be extended should symptoms persist.
- Respublica to check in with the student
- Should the symptoms persist for more than 5 days, NICD/university to be contacted

### 2. EXPOSURE TO COVID-19: Response when a student comes into contact with a person confirmed to have Covid-19 or a person that is testing for Covid-19



#### OPTION A: If this is you...

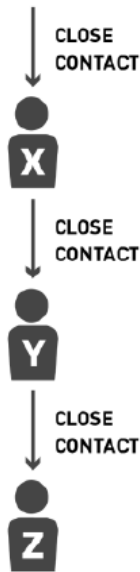
- Inform their Res Manager Immediately
- Go into quarantine (either self-quarantine or dedicated quarantine area)
- For a period of 14 days from the last contact with +VE person.
- If you display one or more symptoms within that period, Respublica will contact NICD/university on advice for testing.

#### OPTION B & C: If this is you...

- You are ok! Practice physical distancing, wear your mask, and watch for symptoms of the virus.
- If you do display one or more symptoms, contact the Res Manager

**OPTION X: If this is you...**

- a) Follow the guidance for Option "A" above until you learn that the person tested negative.
- b) If they test positive, then keep following advice for Option "A".

**OPTION Y: If this is you...**

- a) Follow the guidance for Option "B & C" above until you learn that the person tested negative.
- b) If they test positive, then keep following advice for OPTION "B & C"

**OPTION Z: If this is you...**

- a) You are ok! Practice physical distancing and monitor for symptoms of the virus.
- b) If you do display one or more symptoms, contact take the Res Manager

**3. TESTING FOR COVID-19: Responding to students that are testing for Covid-19**

- a) Student to inform the Res Manager / Respublica Wellness Agent **IMMEDIATELY**
- b) Student to quarantine according
- c) Contact tracing to be conducted
- d) Remain in quarantine until test results are received. If negative, stop quarantine. If positive, refer to point 4 below.

**4. TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19: Responding to a student that is confirmed positive with Covid-19**

- a) Student to inform the Res Manager IMMEDIATELY
- b) Student to be moved to a dedicated isolation room
  - If symptomatic – student is to be in isolation for 14 days from onset of symptoms
  - If asymptomatic – student is to be in isolation for 14 days from the positive test result date
- c) Contact tracing to be conducted
- d) There is no need to re-test after the required isolation period
- e) A person is to wear a surgical mask for 21 days from the onset of symptoms.
- f) Friends of this student to follow the protocol as per point 2 above
